What you should know:

- The Municipality invites you to enjoy the skating rinks during the weekend in compliance with the sanitary instructions issued by the Quebec government.
 - Davis Park Rink: 138 Soulières Crescent
 - Luskville Recreation Park Skating Rink: 3206 Route 148
 - Quyon Recreation Park Skating Rink: 2 Ferry Road

- The following measures must be respected in order to follow the sanitary instructions issued by the Quebec government:
 - Practice of free skating and hockey in solo or with members of your family bubble only;
 - No hockey games allowed;
 - Limit of 15 people for the Luskville and Quyon rinks;
 - Limit of 9 persons for Davis rink;
 - Maintain a distance of two metres from other people at all times;
 - Closing of the ice rinks at 7:30 p.m.
