### **What you should know:**

- The latest government measures announced on Saturday, October 11, 2020, placing the Outaouais region in the Red Alert Zone, bring several new restrictions: <https://www.msss.gouv.qc.ca/ministere/salle-de-presse/communique-2366/>
- Consequently, due to this government obligation, the Municipality is **cancelling all bookings** in its community centers as of **Thursday, October 15, 2020 until further notice**.
- The libraries will remain open, but **only for the contactless lending counter**.
- Taxation and Urban Planning services **will be reduced as of Thursday, October 15, 2020 until further notice** and will only be available via email, telephone or mail.
