PUBLIC NOTICE

IS HEREBY GIVEN by the undersigned, Director general of the aforesaid Municipality, THAT:

THE THREE YEAR ASSESSMENT ROLL for the Municipality of Pontiac coming into effect during the next three fiscal years i.e. 2014, 2015 and 2016, was deposited in my office on September 10, 2013. Any person wishing to consult it may do so during regular office hours.

In conformity with the provisions of article 74.1 of the Act Respecting Municipal Taxation, notice is also given that any person may file an application for review, in virtue of section 1 of chapter X of this law, if they wish to contest the correctness, the presence or absence of an entry on the roll relating to their property.

To be received, an application for review must meet the following conditions:

- must be filed during the course of the fiscal year in which some event justifies a modification to the roll in virtue of the law or during the course of the following fiscal year;
- be filed at the following address or sent there by registered mail :

- be filed on the form prescribed for these ends, which is available at the above noted address;
- be accompanied by the sum of money determined by by-law 97-43 of the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais and applicable to the unit of assessment aimed at in the application for review.
