

**Come visit for free
Forêt-la-Blanche Ecological Reserve
And it's treasures!**



Gatineau, April 8, 2019 — Through a partnership with the **Friends of the Forêt-la-Blanche**, all library patrons of the **Réseau BIBLIO de l'Outaouais** can now **borrow a free pass** to their local library to visit the **Forêt-la-Blanche Ecological Reserve** and discover, through walking trails, one of the last old-growth forests in Quebec with some trees found along paths that are over 400 years old. The Forêt-la-Blanche Ecological Reserve is open throughout the year.

Forty-six passes are in circulation, distributed among the libraries that are members of Réseau BIBLIO de l'Outaouais. Each pass allows 2 adults and 3 children 16 and under to discover the riches of the Forêt-la-Blanche Ecological Reserve. Subscribers can borrow this pass for up to 2 consecutive weeks as many times as they wish.
