



## Preventive notice: Rising water levels

Municipality of Pontiac

October 24, 2020 – 9:00 p.m.

### What you should know:

- This is a **preventive notice** regarding rising water levels.
- The *ministère de la Sécurité publique du Québec* (MSP) is warning residents in low-lying areas along the Ottawa River of a possible rise in levels of 30 to 50 cm over the weekend due to heavy rains expected in the northern portion of the watershed.
- However, levels are expected to remain **below minor flood** levels reached last spring.
- The Municipality of Pontiac continues to monitor water levels and would like to remind residents to take necessary precautions.
